BEING IN LOVE



Fall for someone means to begin to have romantic feelings for that person.

Fall in love means to begin to feel loving feelings for that person.

Be attracted to someone means that you have romantic feelings for them.

Be compatible with someone means that it is easy for you to get along with them and that you enjoy spending time with each other.

Have a lot in common means that you have a lot of the same interests and hobbies as another person and so you find it easy to talk to them.

To be engaged to someone means that you have agreed to marry them but have not yet married them.

To propose means to ask someone to marry you.

To stand someone up - it means that you had a date planned with them but you did not show up or tell them that you were not going to show up.

Blind date is a date where the people have not met each other before. Usually the date has been suggested by someone who is friends with both of the people who go on the date.

Double date is when two couples go out together on a date.

Dutch treat is when each person pays for their own activities and food on a date.

An affair is a relationship between two people, one or both of whom are married to someone else.

Romance refers to the feelings of love.

Smitten describes the feeling of beginning to be in love with someone.

Sweetheart is the person that you have romantic feelings for.

Unrequited - If you have romantic feelings for someone but they do not have romantic feelings for you, your love for them is "unrequited."

Long Distance Relationship

If you are in a long distance relationship with someone, that means that you are in a romantic relationship with them but that they live far away from you.

Matchmaker

A "matchmaker" is someone who likes to introduce people to each other who they think might be romantically interested in each other.
