

## **MINI-DIALOGUES**



### 1. Ordering Food (Falling ↘ for statements, Rising ↗ for questions)

- A: Hi, can I get a coffee, please? ( $\searrow$ )
- B: Sure! Small, medium, or large? (↗)
- $\blacksquare$  A: Medium, please. ( $\searrow$ )
- B: Anything else? (↗)
- **●** A: No, that's all. (↘)

#### 2. Making Plans (Rising *r* for uncertainty, Falling *r* for confirmation)

- A: Are you free this evening?  $(\nearrow)$
- **B:** Hmm... I think so. Why?  $(\nearrow)$
- A: Let's go to the cinema!  $(\searrow)$
- B: Sounds great! What time? (↗)
- A: 7 PM. See you there?  $(\nearrow)$

# 3. Asking for Directions (Rising $\nearrow$ for questions, Falling $\searrow$ for instructions)

- A: Excuse me, where's the nearest bank? ( $\searrow$ )
- **B**: Go straight ( $\searrow$ ), turn left at the lights ( $\searrow$ ), and it's on the right. ( $\searrow$ )
- A: So... left at the lights? (↗)
- **B:** Yes! You can't miss it. ( $\searrow$ )
- A: Thanks a lot!  $(\searrow)$

### 4. Expressing Surprise (Rising-Falling ↗↘)

- A: Guess what?! (↗↘)
- B: What?! (↗↘)
- A: I won a free holiday!  $(\nearrow)$
- B: No way! That's amazing! (↗↘)

### 5. A Small Apology (Falling > for sincerity)

- A: Sorry I'm late! (↘)
- **\blacksquare B:** What happened? ( $\searrow$ )
- **\blacksquare A:** The bus was delayed. ( $\searrow$ )
- **P B:** No worries. Let's go.  $(\searrow)$

# 6. At the Coffee Shop (Rising $\nearrow$ for questions, Falling $\searrow$ for statements)

- A: Can I have a cappuccino, please? ( $\searrow$ )
- B: Sure! Would you like it hot or iced? (↗)
- A: Hot, please.  $(\searrow)$
- B: Anything else? (↗)
- A: No, that's all.  $(\searrow)$

# 7. Discussing the Weather (Falling $\searrow$ for statements, Rising $\nearrow$ for uncertainty)

- A: It's really cold today, isn't it? ( $\searrow$ )
- B: Yeah, it's freezing! (↘)
- **•** A: Do you think it will snow?  $(\nearrow)$
- B: I'm not sure... maybe. (↗)

#### 8. At the Grocery Store (Rising $\nearrow$ for questions, Falling $\searrow$ for answers)

- A: How much is the bread?  $(\nearrow)$
- **B:** It's £1.50. (↘)
- **\blacksquare A:** I'll take two, please. ( $\checkmark$ )
- B: Anything else? (↗)

# 9. Making a Suggestion (Rising *才* for uncertainty, Falling *⊾* for confirmation)

- A: How about going to the park this afternoon?  $(\nearrow)$
- **\blacksquare B:** That sounds great! ( $\searrow$ )
- A: We can have a picnic if the weather is nice. ( $\searrow$ )
- **9 B:** I'd love that!  $(\searrow)$

# 10. Giving Directions (Falling $\searrow$ for statements, Rising $\nearrow$ for questions)

• A: Can you tell me how to get to the station?  $(\nearrow)$ 

**B:** Sure. Go straight ( $\searrow$ ), take the second right ( $\searrow$ ), and it's just ahead. ( $\searrow$ )

- A: So, straight and then right? ( $\nearrow$ )
- **\blacksquare B:** Yes, that's it! ( $\searrow$ )

### 11. At the Restaurant (Rising $\nearrow$ for questions, Falling $\searrow$ for answers)

- A: Do you have vegetarian options? (↗)
- **B:** Yes, we do. (↘)
- A: I'll have the veggie burger, please. ( $\searrow$ )
- B: Great choice! (↘)

# 12. Discussing Plans (Rising *r* for uncertainty, Falling *r* for decisions)

- A: Are we meeting at 7 or 8? ( $\nearrow$ )
- **B**: Let's go for 7, that's fine with me. ( $\searrow$ )
- A: Okay, see you then!  $(\searrow)$
- **B:** See you! (↘)

#### 13. Offering Help (Rising *∧* for offering, Falling *∨* for answering)

- A: Do you need help with that?  $(\nearrow)$
- **P B:** Yes, please!  $(\searrow)$
- A: I can carry those bags for you. ( $\searrow$ )
- **9 B:** Thanks a lot!  $(\searrow)$

### 14. Expressing Surprise (Rising-Falling ↗↘)

- A: I just got a promotion!  $(\nearrow)$
- B: No way! That's fantastic! (↗↘)
- A: I know! I'm so excited! (↗↘)

### 15. Apologizing (Falling > for sincerity)

- A: I'm really sorry for what happened earlier. ( $\searrow$ )
- B: It's okay, I understand. (↘)
- A: I'll make it up to you. ( $\searrow$ )
- **P B:** No need, really.  $(\searrow)$
