



## VOCABULARY AND FUNCTIONS UNDERSTANDING



### Basic Understanding

1. **I understand.** — *I understand what you mean about saving money.*
2. **I get it.** — *Oh, I get it now. You were joking!*
3. **I see.** — *I see, so the meeting is tomorrow, not today.*
4. **That makes sense.** — *That makes sense. the shop closes early on Sundays.*
5. **I know what you mean.** — *I know what you mean; Mondays can be really hard.*
6. **I get what you're saying.** — *I get what you're saying about needing more time.*
7. **Right, I follow you.** — *Right, I follow you. We should start from step one again.*
8. **Now I understand.** — *Now I understand why you were upset.*
9. **I see what you mean.** — *I see what you mean. That could be a problem.*
10. **Got it.** — *Got it, I'll bring the documents tomorrow.*

### Phrases for Not Understanding

1. **I don't understand.** — *I don't understand this part of the exercise.*
2. **I don't get it.** — *Sorry, I don't get it — can you explain again?*
3. **I'm not sure I understand.** — *I'm not sure I understand what you mean by that.*
4. **I don't see what you mean.** — *I don't see what you mean about the schedule.*
5. **I'm confused.** — *I'm confused — is the class on Monday or Tuesday?*
6. **You lost me.** — *Wait, you lost me — who are we talking about now?*
7. **Sorry, what do you mean?** — *Sorry, what do you mean by "shift the deadline"?*
8. **Could you explain that again?** — *Could you explain that again? I didn't quite catch it.*
9. **Can you say that another way?** — *Can you say that another way? I didn't understand.*
10. **I'm not following you.** — *I'm not following you. Could you give me an example?*

### To Confirm You Understand

1. **So, you mean...?** — *So, you mean we have to finish by Friday?*
2. **Do you mean that...?** — *Do you mean that the class is canceled?*
3. **If I understand you correctly...** — *If I understand you correctly, we meet at the station, right?*
4. **Let me check I got this right.** — *Let me check I got this right — you'll call me later?*
5. **In other words...** — *In other words, we're starting over from the beginning?*
