

10 - VOCABULARY: AGE



Foetus: unborn baby that is growing inside its mum's womb.
Infant: a child during the earliest period of its life.
Baby: a newborn or recently born child; infant
Child: a person between birth and full growth; a boy or girl:
Toddler: a child who has only recently learnt to walk
Teenager: An adolescent; a person who is between 13 and 19 years old
Adult: a person who is fully grown, developed, or of age:
Elderly person: A person who is quite old; past middle age

Infancy: from the moment the baby is born up to 1 year of age the period is infancy
Childhood: the period of life when they are a child (from 1 to 10)
Puberty: the period of a person's life during which their sexual organs develop and they become capable of having children
Adolescence: the period in human development between puberty and adulthood.
Adulthood: the period in the human lifespan in which full physical and intellectual maturity have been attained
Middle age: the period of your life when you are neither young nor old, between the ages of about 45 and 60
Old age: the period of your life when you are are old

How can you tell someone's age politely? She's **in her** thirties= she's between 30 and 39... You can be more precise... **in his early** forties (41-42- 43), **in her mid**-fifties (= middle fifties) = (55-56-57), **in his late** seventies (78-79). She's in her late teens, (= 18 or 19) She is 49 but next month she will **tun** 50
